

Congratulations and thank you for choosing King Dimensions Turkey Trophy mounting kit. This high quality American made product will allow you to proudly display your trophy for years to come. If you have questions, concerns or comments, email us from our website at www.kingdimensions.com.

Follow the easy step-by-step instructions to mount your display. Included in your kit are the following items:

- * Solid oak, three dimensional display plaque
- * Natural Preservative (Borax) **SEE CAUTION BELOW**
- * Beard retainer molded from engineering grade resin
- * Fully adjustable, metal fan retainer/wall plate (Patent Pending)
- * (3) Mounting screws (1 ¼" long)
- * T-pins to establish the "set" of your fan
- * Decorative metal plate for engraving (Engraved letters will appear gold)

Step 1: Carefully remove the tail from your turkey. Don't be afraid to leave some of the smaller feathers at the base of the tail as they add to the appearance of your mount. Using a sharp knife or razor blade, carefully remove the excess flesh from the base of the tail. Be careful not to cut through the skin or feathers.

Step 2: Remove the beard from your turkey. Make this cut as close to the turkey breast as possible. You can trim excess flesh away from the base, leaving approximately ½" of flesh to retain all the beard hairs.

Step 3: Liberally rub preservative (**SEE CAUTION BELOW**) into and around all the fleshy areas of the tail and beard. As the tail and beard dry over the next week or so, feel free to remove any other excess flesh or fatty tissue that you see. Again, be careful not to cut through the remaining skin. If you do lose feathers from the tail or hairs from the beard, they can be glued back in later. Rub in any extra preservative that you may have left over.

Step 4: Using the t-pins supplied, fan out your turkey tail to the desired final appearance you want it to have. You can pin the tail to a cardboard box or piece of Styrofoam. This will hold it in place while it dries over the next week or two.

Step 5: Tightly wrap the fleshy end of the beard with a good quality electrical or adhesive tape (not included). This will help to keep all the hairs in tact over the life of your mount. Store your fan and beard in a cool (room temperature), dry area while drying. We do not recommend outside storage since insects might be attracted to the fleshy portions of your trophy and could destroy them.

Step 6: After the tail and beard have dried into position (this usually takes place in about two weeks) you're ready to mount them on your display plaque:

First take the beard and insert it into the beard retainer. There is a sharp point in the retainer to help hold the beard in position. Using (1) one of screws provided, screw the retainer to the plaque in the single hole near the bottom of the retainer. (See Illustration on back of packaging insert) There is a pre-drilled hole in the back of the wood plaque to guide this screw into place.

Next take the metal adjustable fan retainer/wall plate and using a pliers or screw driver, bend the three tabs in slightly. The tabs can be bent in more or less to adjust for whatever thickness your tail might be. It is important to bend the tabs in the right direction. (See Illustration on back of packaging insert)

Set the tail in place on the back of the plaque and insert the fan retainer/wall plate into position. If you feel that the tension is adequate to hold the tail in place, screw the remaining (2) screws provided through both the metal fan retainer plate and the beard retainer and into wood plaque. Again, there are pre-drilled holes in the back of the wood plaque to guide these screws into place. (See Illustration on back of packaging insert)

If you feel the turkey tail is too loose, simply remove the top two screws and remove the metal plate. Adjust the tabs in further and reassemble.

Step 7: Take your decorative display plate to your local engraver to add the personal information and details you wish to show. The letters will engrave gold in color. After the engraving is complete and using the double sided tape provided, attach the plate to the front of the plaque. You can hang your completed mount by the screw hole provided on the metal fan retainer/wall plate. You are now ready to display and enjoy your King Dimensions Turkey Trophy.

CAUTION: While Borax is considered a non-irritant to eyes and skin, Borax is not intended to be ingested. If Borax does get in your eyes, use fresh water to flush eyes. If you accidentally ingest Borax, drink two glasses of water and seek medical attention.
